A guided fossil walk and workshop at Dinosaur Isle Museum

Itinerary (afternoon times are approximate)

10 am: Meet at Dinosaur Isle to register, then to Yaverland beach to collect an array of fossils and rocks from the beach (bring a bucket or strong plastic bag).

12 noon: Return to Dinosaur Isle where tea and coffee will be available.

12:15 pm: Examine your found objects in Dinosaur Isle's classroom to learn more about what they are, and represent.

The cliffs at Yaverland, and the foreshore, are a fantastic geological exposure from the time of the early Cretaceous. The wide range of rock types and colours are representative of the ancient environments and provide a source of information about the former river floodplains, lakes, beaches and seas that were here before the Island we know today.
