



Walk to the Chalk

Saturday 15th September 2018

A guided geology, landscape and fossil walk by Dinosaur Isle.

A walk along the surf-line at low-tide from Dinosaur Isle to the Chalk platform below Culver Cliff. Learn about the different environments recorded in the geology of the cliffs over a 40 million year time span.

Bring a light snack to eat whilst we rest at the base of Culver. Then explore for fossils in the Grey Chalk beach before walking back amongst the fossil-rich exposures of the Wealden foreshore.

This walk will cover 4 to 5 kilometres on soft sand, and possibly exposed hard muds. Access at Yaverland is via a short flight of steps. There are toilets at the museum and in Yaverland car-park.

Meet at Dinosaur Isle. The walk will last over 2 hours.
